GLOUCESTERSHIRE AGAINST the INCINERATOR

SAY "NO" BEFORE IT IS TOO LATE*

 Favoured waste control option of the current Gloucestershire County Council (GCC) is said to be the building of a giant incinerator (up to 10 stories high). Javelin Park, Gloucester (purchased for £7.4 million by GCC) is one potential site.

(Note that there <u>are</u> environmentally friendly options.)

*Health Threats from giant Incinerator:

- "Serious health effects" from particulate emissions in air "transported over long distances" (*WHO) "25 miles" (*PAIN)
- Toxic fly ash (*EU, HMG & Environment Agency) transported across Glos. The likely landfill site is near Bishops Cleeve.
- Increased heavy transport across Glos., bringing in waste.

*Environmental Threats from giant Incinerator:

- Changes focus from reducing waste, to feeding the monster.
- Valuable materials would be incinerated.
- Increased affect on global warming.

*Financial Threats from giant Incinerator:

- *GCC is offering a £646 million PFI residual waste (150,000 tpa) contract for 25-35 years, to be paid for by local taxpayer.
- Reduction in house values in the area.
